## Tasks and Deadlines for Visiting Students: UNL Faculty-Led: Italy: Sicily Mummy Studies

## Please note the following deadlines:

**As Soon As Possible**: upload scanned copy of **valid passport** in MyWorld and complete corresponding questionnaire.

**4/20** Deadline to register through MyRed; the Department will provide students with a permission code to register for the course in MyRed. The course is a regular UNL three credit hour course offered for a grade. This class is required of all participants in the summer program, and you will be billed for three credit hours of UNL tuition and fees.

**4/20** University of Nebraska-Lincoln (UNL) Visiting Student Application Deadline: In addition to Myworld, visiting students must apply to UNL through the Office of Admissions. To apply, students need to complete the online application here: **https://admissions.unl.edu/apply/#admission-requirements/visiting**. Students will be required to pay the \$45 application fee.

**5/24** Deadline to submit Health Clearance Form to Education Abroad Office if accommodations requested.

**6/22** Deadline to upload UnitedHealthcare Global Insurance card to MyWorld application. The Education Abroad Office will register you in the insurance in early April and you will receive a confirmation email, which will include information about how to download your card.

**6/22** Deadline to submit Health Clearance Form to Education Abroad Office if no accommodations requested. **Also, all remaining MyWorld application items must be complete.** 

**7/23** Education Abroad Office will enroll students S.T.E.P. (Smart Traveler Enrollment Program) to reflect participation in the program.
